

Shipbrokers contributes to the activities of NESA

Tomi Rautio, Chairman of Shipbrokers Finland, has been invited to be part of NESA's Maritime Transport Pool Committee.

The Maritime Transport Pool operating within the logistics sector of the National Emergency Supply Agency (NESA) promotes co-operation between business life and the authorities in matters of national preparedness. The work is directed by the Pool Committee comprised of representatives from different companies, organisations and authorities within the field.

The five industries within the Maritime Transport Pool include shipping companies, port operators, ports, forwarding agents as well as new construction and maintenance and repair services.

The Maritime Transport Pool

- works together with other organisations in the field and authorities to further the operational conditions for Finnish navigation.
- advances collaboration for preparedness between companies within the maritime transport and other logistics fields and the authorities.
- maintains a register of critical companies in terms of security of supply.
- helps to maintain a situational picture of the security of supply within transport and logistics as well as to implement measures to advance the security of supply.
- organises training sessions and exercises related to preparedness.

The Maritime Transport Pool may invite those member companies of Shipbrokers Finland that it views as supporting Finland's security of supply to contribute to its activities.
